Final storm debris sweep set for Monday

The City of Slidell's garbage and trash collector, Coastal Waste Services, along with city Public Works personnel, began their final streets sweep of storm-related debris from Hurricane Gustav on Monday, Sept. 15.

The pick-ups will begin in south Slidell and move northward until the job is completed. The items to be collected include "green debris" such as downed tree limbs and the like, and "white goods" such as refrigerators, freezers and other appliances damaged as a result of the storm flooding, winds or lightning.

The items for pickup must be placed on the street curb. Coastal Waste and city workers will not be pulling debris and damaged items from interior yards, carports or open garages.
