City of Slidell Resumes Utility Billing

The City of Slidell will resume utility billing in November to residents and businesses who receive water, sewer and garbage pickup services from the city. Due to the damage caused by Hurricane Katrina, utility bills will be mailed the first or second week of November. The bills are for services for August, September, October, November, and December and will include a Hurricane Katrina Credit for one of those months. All late fees and penalties will be waived through January 2006. The total balance will be due on January 20, 2006.

January services will be billed on February 1, 2006. Bank drafts will be discontinued until February 2006.

If a current customer wishes to disconnect services and return to the same address, the \$60 Service Fee will be waived.
