Held on a Saturday afternoon to follow the Camellia City Farmer's Market, "Matinee After the Market," will include recession-friendly concessions and tables for easy dining. The event will be held on Saturday, September 12 at noon. Doors will open at 11:30 a.m.

Concessions will include soft drinks, chips, candy, and pickles on sale for \$1 and hot dogs for \$2. Seating will include tables so that families may sit down together to enjoy their dinner while watching the movie.
