Recently, City of Slidell workers participated in several cleanup and capital improvement projects in District F, as part of the administration's "District Day," which targets different city council districts one at a time on a monthly basis.

"It was another very productive day," said Mayor Ben Morris, explaining that around 30 city workers picked up debris, cleaned

out storm drains, washed signs and cut grass on the west side of town. The event was last held in October in District D.
