‘Sit back and let the evening go’ with Sgt. Peppers Band

Bayou Jam concert-goers will embark on a Magical Mystery Tour in Heritage Park on Sunday, May 16, when Sgt. Peppers, a popular Beatles tribute band, takes the amphitheater stage at 5:30 p.m. Admission is free.

Sgt. Peppers Band is comprised of four accomplished musicians who bring all the magic and energy of the Beatles to enthusiastic audiences throughout the South. The show is a multi-period, multi-costumed, multi-media sensory journey; a Magical Mystery Tour that winds from the clubs of Liverpool and Hamburg down Abbey Road to a London rooftop.

Like many Beatles tribute bands, Sgt. Peppers plays material covering the Fab Four's entire recording career. Unlike most, however, Sgt. Peppers tackles even the most complex arrangements, playing all the parts live with unbelievable attention to detail.

Bayou Jam is now in its eighth year of free concerts in Heritage Park. The concert series has become a great way for family and friends to come together and celebrate their love of music and community spirit. Concert-goers are invited to bring their chairs, blankets, ice chests and picnic baskets to the park to enjoy the concerts. Soft drinks, bottled water and on-site catering will be available for a nominal charge. Please note that park regulations prohibit pets in the park as well as the use of skateboards, scooters, barbeque grills and glass items.
