#### Salad Days Juried Student Art Exhibition

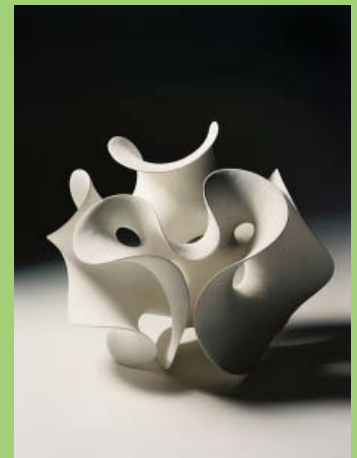
April 8 - June 10, 2011 ♦ Opening reception: Friday, April 8, 6 - 8 p.m.

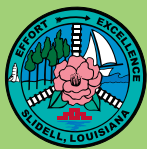


### KidsFest Children's Art Festival
