CALL FOR ENTRIES

The City of Slidell's Department of Cultural & Public Affairs is proud to present *Reinterpreting the Masters*, an exhibit that challenges artists to provide their own artistic interpretation of celebrated works of Master artists. The object of the show is not to duplicate, but to recreate the work in a completely different style of art.

JURORS

The Commission on the Arts is a community advisory board to the City of Slidell's Department of Cultural & Public Affairs. Established in 1979, the commission provides guidance and advice to the mayor, city council and other city agencies regarding grants, cultural projects and policies. Commissioners are appointed by the mayor with the primary function to develop, nurture and sustain the cultural life of the community.

AWARDS

Artists will receive recognition for first, second and third place. Honorable mention(s) will be awarded at the jurors' discretion. Cash prizes will be awarded as follows: \$300 for first place, \$200 for second place and \$100 for third place.

DELIVERY & ENTRY

Artists may enter up to three works for a flat entry fee of \$20. Entry must be the original work of the artist only and must have been created within the past year. Please bring your completed entry form, entry fee (please make checks payable to City of Slidell) and art work to the Slidell Cultural Center (located at 2055 Second St. on the first floor of City Hall) on Monday, Sept. 28 from 2 to 6 p.m. or Tuesday, Sept. 29, from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. No late entries will be accepted. Entry form must include value of each piece for insurance purposes. Work need not be for sale. All entries must be available to display in the exhibit for the full duration of the show and art work may not be removed from the exhibit before the close of the show. The Commission on the Arts reserves the right to choose not to display art work presented for this exhibition. This is a juried exhibit. As such, not all works entered will be selected for exhibition.

By entering your art work in this exhibit, you are agreeing to allow the City of Slidell to photograph your work for promotional materials, without further compensation. Entry in this exhibit establishes an agreement on the

part of the artist to all of these conditions. You are also certifying that you understand the rules of entry.

SIZE & HANGING REQUIREMENTS

All hanging art work must not exceed a total weight of 30 pounds. Due to the gallery's hanging system, all works must be prepared for hanging with a secured wire hanger. All work must be submitted dry, finished and ready to show. Three-dimensional work must be delivered ready to exhibit. Additionally, the maximum size for art work is 60" wide by 60" high, including mat and frame. Freestanding art work must not exceed 6' high or 36" wide. Works on canvas must be framed or gallery wrapped. Each work must be labeled with the artist's name, telephone number and address displayed on the back of each piece.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists 16 years or older. Work must be original, completed within the past year and not previously exhibited in the Slidell Cultural Center.

LIABILITY

Utmost care will be exercised in the handling of entries. However, the City of Slidell will assume responsibility for damage or loss of accepted entries only for the period of time in which each piece of art is in the facility. The City of Slidell will not assume responsibility for works in transit or unaccepted entries not picked up by 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 6 or for accepted works not picked up by 1 p.m. on Dec. 15, 2009.

PICKUP REQUIREMENTS

Due to space limitations, we are unable to store any shipping materials or art work not accepted into the show. Upon closing of the exhibit, art work must be picked up from the Slidell Cultural Center on Monday, Dec. 14, from 2 to 6 p.m. or on Tuesday, Dec. 15, from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. *The gallery will only be open during pickup hours.* Work left past this deadline will become the property of the City of Slidell unless other arrangements have been made with the city. If you are unable to pickup work on these dates, please call (985) 646-4375 before Dec. 11 to make other arrangements.
