## Call for Entries

The Commission on the Arts is sponsoring a juried exhibition of student artwork in conjunction with the City of Slidell's Department of Cultural & Public Affairs. Young artists, ages 5-19, are encouraged to enter.

### Juror

For the past thirteen years, Anne Boudreau has exhibited her mixed media collages and three-dimensional fabric constructions in solo, juried and group exhibitions. She received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the University of Southwestern Louisiana with a concentration in photography and received her Master of Fine Arts in painting and sculpture from the University of South Carolina. She was awarded a South Carolina State Arts Commission Fellowship for her mixed media fabric constructions. Until Katrina, she held a faculty/arts administrative position at the New Orleans Center for the Creative Arts (NOCCA|Riverfront) and currently chairs the Visual Arts Department at Lusher Charter School in New Orleans. Her work was recently on display in the Slidell Cultural Center's exhibit "Abstract Expressions."

### Entry

Entry is by original work only. No more than three entries per artist will be accepted. All artwork, with \$5 flat entry fee, must be delivered to the Slidell Art League Gallery, 1827 Front Street in the historic Slidell Train Depot, between 2 p.m. and 6 p.m., Tuesday, April 17, or 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. (noon), Wednesday, April 18. No late entries will be accepted.

### Notification

Notification of acceptance/non-acceptance will be made by mail by Friday, April 20. If artists have not received notification by 2 p.m., April 24, call 646-4375.

### Art Pick Up

Work not accepted must be picked up between 2 p.m. and 6 p.m., Wednesday, April 25. Accepted work must remain in the facility for the duration of the exhibit. At the close of the exhibit, accepted work must be picked up between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Wednesday, June 6. Work left 30 days past this deadline becomes the property of the City of Slidell.

## Important Note

The Commission on the Arts reserves the right to choose not to display any piece of artwork presented for exhibition in the Salad Days Exhibition. Entry fees are non-refundable. Not all entries will be displayed.

### Eligibility

All artists between the ages of 5 and 19 years, residing in St. Tammany Parish, are eligible (college students are not eligible). Each artist is limited to three entries. Work will be judged in the following four age categories:

- A 5 - 8 years of age
- B 9 - 11 years of age
- C 12 - 14 years of age
- D 15 - 19 years of age

A \$50 prize will be awarded to one winner in each age category. Each accepted artist will receive a medallion from the Slidell Art League.

### Requirements

Work may be submitted in all media. Work must not exceed 60" in any direction. Work must be original, completed within the past two years, and not previously exhibited at the Slidell Cultural Center. Work need not be for sale. All work delivered must be dry. All work must be labeled on the back with title, artist's name, age, and phone number, and an indication of the top of the piece. **Glass or plexiglass must cover works on paper.** Simple framing is preferred. **NEW REQUIREMENT: All work must be completely prepared for hanging with a secured wire hanger - no claws or hooks can be utilized.** No work will be taped or glued to the walls. Wires or string taped to the work will **not** be accepted. **Two-dimensional work that does not meet these hanging requirements cannot be accepted.**

### Liability

The Commission on the Arts will assume responsibility for damage or loss of entries (up to 50% of stated value, or \$50, whichever is less) only for the period of time in which pieces of art are in the SAL Gallery (between April 17 and June 6, 2007). The Commission on the Arts will not assume responsibility for work in transit or for work not picked up by the 4 p.m. deadline on June 6. Entry in this exhibit indicates an agreement that the Lendor will indemnify and hold harmless the Lendee against any and all claims Lendor may have arising from the acts of third parties or acts of God.
