Slidell Police Pay it Forward

Chief Drennan along with members of the Slidell Police Department and employees of Slidell Memorial Hospital have started a fund raising effort to aid the people of Haiti. The plan is simple, employees of the Slidell Police Department and Slidell Memorial Hospital will start to collect money that will be sent to Operation Blessing International, who in turn will use the money to purchase Food, Water, Medical Supplies and other needs for the people of Haiti.

Chief Drennan said that during the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina, Operation Blessing was here in Slidell helping everyone. "I was very impressed with what they did for the people after Hurricane Katrina and how well they ran their operation".

To make it easy for people to give, they can either drop their check or money order off at the Slidell Police Department or just give it to any Slidell Police Department Employee.

People wishing to drop their donation off at Slidell Memorial Hospital will need to bring the check or money order to the Human Resources Department located at 1111 Gause Blvd.

The check or money order needs to be made out to Operation Blessing International and in the memo field of the check or money order they are to write "Haiti". This will let Operation Blessing International know that the money is designated for Haiti.
