Update: *Robert Road Gas Station Robbed*

On February 3rd, 2010 Slidell Detectives returned from Tyler, Texas with a suspect that was wanted for the January 7th, 2010 Armed Robbery of a gas station located at 601 Robert Blvd. Gary A. Gilmore, age 26 of 1523 Savannah was transported back to Slidell and was booked with Armed Robbery, Armed Robbery with the use of a Firearm and Possession of a Firearm by a convicted felon. Once booked Gilmore will be transported to the St. Tammany Parish Jail where bond will be set. This release is related to the below release issued on January 8th, 2010.

Also arrested for his part in the Armed Robbery was Rocarldo R. Weiters on January 14th, 2010.

Robert Road Gas Station Robbed

On January 07, 2010, at 10:20 pm the Slidell Police Department responded to an armed robbery at 601 Robert Boulevard (Grumpy's Texaco.) Upon arrival officers learned that a black male entered the store with a revolver drawn and demanded money from the register. The black male walked behind the counter and forced the clerk to open the register. The suspect removed cash from the register and fled the area on foot.

Detectives later retrieved photographs from the video surveillance system, which captured the robbery. The black male appeared to be wearing black cargo pants, a black jacket with some sort of zipper on the shoulders, and a white shirt underneath the jacket. The black male had a Halloween mask covering his face and was also wearing black gloves. He was approximately 5'8" and 220 lbs.
